We are hoping each of our MCDC families can collect a dollar a day to help raise the money.

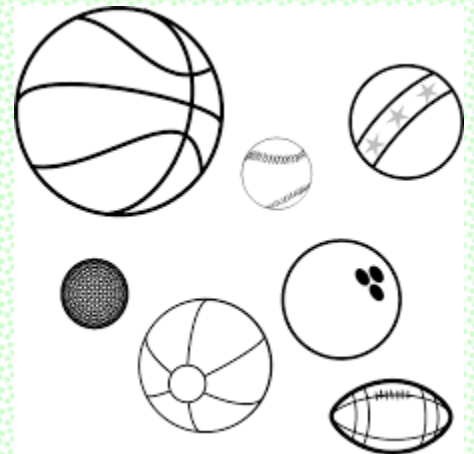
The first collection of "DOLLARS" can be remitted on the 25th day of school:

Once again, we are offering PNO on Friday, September 25th from 6-10 p.m. The price is \$20 for one child, \$30 for 2 children, \$40 for 3 or more children (cash only please). Reservations are required before the event to allow us to staff accordingly. If interested fill out an emergency contact form and return to the office with cash payment by September 23rd. (we will need at least 10 families to participate in order for this event to take place)



Upon your child's first day of school, we need all forms completed from the green folder, if you have not done so already. These forms are required to be updated annually by MSDE.

We appreciate your cooperation.



A change to the MSDE Child Care Regulations: we must offer 1% fat milk or nonfat milk at lunch time, unless otherwise ordered by a health

care provider or requested by the parent.

That means, we can no longer serve drinks sent from home. Water bottles may be sent from home and we can refill them as necessary.

If your child stays for lunch, remember to send in sufficient food that meets the standards of the Child and Adult Care Food Program of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. A chart is located on the parent board that lists the requirements according to age.
