helping to save the planet.

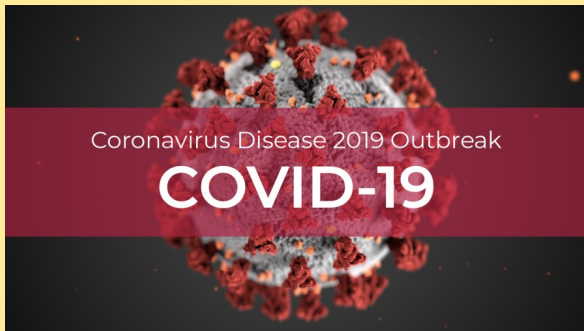


Winter Fundraiser

The Maryland State Department of Education updated the Covid-19 Guidance for Child Care Settings on August 28th, 2020.

It includes: Guidance for Use of Cloth Face Coverings in Child Care Programs, a "Decision Aid" Chart, and Symptom Screening for Child in Child Care that states the 3 questions that the staff of MCDC will be asking at drop off:

Three Questions to Answer... **YES or NO**

???Symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell, fever of 100.4o or higher, chills or shaking chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion or runny nose)

???Waiting for a COVID-19 test result, diagnosed with COVID-19, or instructed by any health care provider or the health department to isolate or quarantine

???In the last 14 days, close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 or suspected of having COVID-19

A temperature check will also be taken by a parent/guardian and be recorded by MCDC staff at time of drop off.
